# Made for the *ritual of the dram.*

---

HyggeHoose is a small Scottish atelier on the East Lothian coast, working in live-edge timber and hand-poured resin. Each piece that leaves the workshop is signed, numbered and one-of-one — and when a design sells, it retires with the buyer.

This brochure has been prepared for the people who care about the object the whisky is poured onto: distillery owners, hospitality directors, head bartenders, buyers and brand custodians who understand that a serving piece is a brand asset in its own right — held, photographed, remembered.

On the pages that follow are the principal commissions we offer to the trade — from intimate flight boards for a tasting room to live-edge bar tops, gifting programmes for VIP customers, and one-of-one heirloom pieces for archive display. Every commission begins with a conversation. We would be glad to begin one with you.

# One pair of *hands. Slowly.*

The studio is intentionally small — every commission passes through the same pair of hands, from the first selection of timber through the resin pour, the long curing, and the final hand-finishing in oil and wax.

We work principally in Scottish and European hardwoods — yew, oak, walnut, burr elm, spalted maple — paired with deep, hand-poured resin tinted to the colour of the Forth and the long Scottish dusk.

# The Whisky Flight.

*A board built around the ritual of the dram.*

— FORMAT —

Three to seven drams

— MATERIALS —

Live-edge yew, oak & walnut

— RESIN —

Hand-poured, Forth-blue palette

— DETAILING —

Solid brass bottle inlay · signed plate

# An object worthy *of the bottle.*

---

Five ways HyggeHoose works with Scotland's distilleries — from the visitor tasting room to single-cask gifting and brand-archive commissions.

## · Tasting-Room Flight Boards

Bespoke flight boards built around your house pour — sized to your glassware, inlaid with brass bottle plinths, finished in resin tones drawn from the distillery's own livery.

## · Single-Cask & Limited-Release Gifting

One-of-one boards or coasters paired with a numbered single-cask release. Each piece signed, numbered and accompanied by a provenance card naming the cask, the buyer and the maker.

## · Brand-Archive & Founder Pieces


Heirloom commissions for the distillery's own collection: a board built from a retired warehouse beam, a console for the founder's office, an under-stair display for the visitor centre.

## · Trade & Industry Awards

Bespoke trophies and presentation pieces for distillery awards, ambassador programmes and long-service gifts. Replaces the engraved-glass cliché with something held and kept.

## · VIP & Brand-Ambassador Gifts

Small editions of coasters, drams trays or pocket-sized tasting boards for VIPs, brand ambassadors and trade visitors — quietly signed on the underside.

# Pieces guests *remember.*

---

Quiet, photographable objects for the bar back, the snug, the suite and the private dining room. Built to survive nightly service and to be inherited.

- **Live-Edge Bar Tops & Back-Bar Shelves**

One-of-one bar tops and shelving in burr elm, oak and yew, with optional resin rivers drawn from the property's location — Forth-blue, peat, sand, harbour-stone.

- **Tasting Boards & Service Pieces**

Whisky flights, gin paddles, oyster trays, charcuterie boards — sized to your glassware and finished to your livery. Replaceable hand-finished oils for long service life.

- **In-Room & Suite Pieces**

Coasters, dram trays, side tables and decanter plinths for signature suites and residences. Each piece numbered to the room it lives in.

- **Concierge & Departure Gifts**

Pocket coasters, signed boards and miniature flight pieces for the highest-tier guests. Branded discreetly on the underside, never on the face.

- **Lobby & Archive Commissions**

Statement console tables, under-stair cabinetry and feature walls in live-edge timber and deep resin pours — the centrepieces guests photograph and tag.

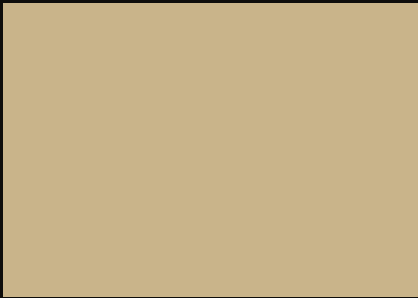

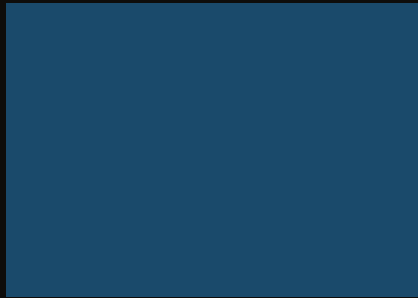

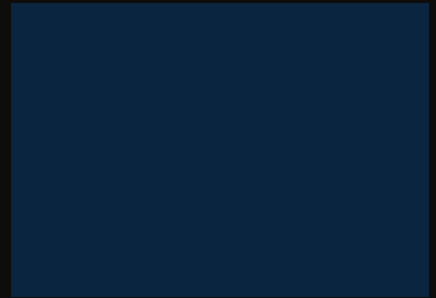

# From conversation *to delivery.*

---

## 01 The Brief

A short call or visit to the workshop. We discuss intent, audience, glassware, livery, palette, and the story you would like the piece to carry.

## 02 Sketch & Selection

Within ten days you receive sketches, a timber selection (with photographs of the actual boards on the bench), and a resin palette swatch.

## 03 Maker's Estimate

A signed maker's estimate naming the materials, the dimensions, the lead time, and a fixed price. No surprises later.

## 04 Make

The slow work. Stabilising, pouring, curing, planing, hand-finishing in oil and wax. Photographs sent at each stage if you wish.

## 05 Sign, Number, Deliver

Each piece is signed and numbered on the underside. Hand-delivered within Scotland; insured courier elsewhere in the UK.

4 — 12 weeks per commission

*Larger, more complex pieces by arrangement.*

Every commission is priced individually, against the timber selected, the scale of the pour, the detailing, and the hours at the bench. We do not publish a rate card — the work does not lend itself to one.
